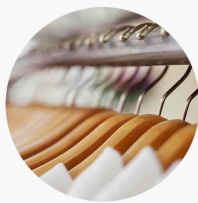

All things ATX & Music Festivals, skylines, and bats, oh my!

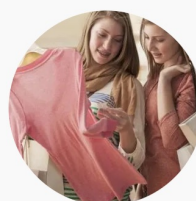

DoubleTake ATX Donation Requests & Guidelines

Items SHOULD be:

- Relatively clean (we clean most on receipt)
- On-trend, reasonably fashionable or vintage (before '00)
- Like new, new or low signs of wear
- In working condition, contain all parts

Items should NOT be:

- Damaged, dirty, showing excessive wear
- Broken, not working, or missing pieces
- Containing inappropriate slogans, visuals
- Too large to fit in a van or small SUV

DoubleTake ATX does not accept these items

Unfortunately, some items are restricted for resale by the Texas Department of Health Services; others may be too large or difficult for our staff and volunteers to manage. We graciously accept what we are able to sell in our store; however, we may redistribute to other nonprofits that are better equipped to sell, use, upcycle or dispose of the item(s) in an ecologically friendly manner.
