Items **SHOULD** be:

- Relatively clean (we clean most on receipt)
- On-trend, reasonably fashionable
- Like new, new or low signs of wear
- In working condition, contain all parts

Items **should NOT** be:

- Damaged, dirty, showing excessive wear
- Broken, not working, or missing pieces
- Containing inappropriate slogans, visuals
- Too large to fit in a van or small SUV

DoubleTake ATX does not accept these items

Unfortunately, some items are restricted for resale by the Texas Department of Health Services; others may be too large or difficult for our staff and volunteers to manage. We graciously accept what we are able to sell in our store, consign for cash at local consignment shops, or redistribute to other nonprofits that are better equipped to sell, use, or dispose of the item(s) in an ecologically-friendly manner.
